



“AN AFRICAN, FAMILY ADVENTURE”

Tour: KNP / Panorama & Adventure

No of persons: Min 2

Dates: Hunting Season

Duration: 5 Nights / 6 Days

Meals: (B - Breakfast, L - Lunch, D - Dinner)

* Accommodation is subject to availability, if the under mentioned accommodation is not available we shall endeavor to supply comparable facilities.

Day 1:

Depart early morning, after breakfast from your hunting camp. Travel to the world famous Kruger National Park (KNP). There are a number of interesting places or attractions we could visit on the various routes to the park, the route we take can only be determined on confirmation of accommodation (due to availability). Some of these attractions would be shopping at Gemco Studio, which is known for its “African arts and crafts”, a visit to Bakone Malapa Pedi Cultural Village, Sapeco Tea Estate or the “Big Tree” - which is the largest Baobab in the world at ± 6000 years old. Enter the KNP at one of the northern gates, at an ideal time of the day for some game spotting. Lunch can be enjoyed on route and dinner will be served at the camps restaurant. Overnight in the KNP.

Accommodation: Mopani / Letaba or Olifants Camp *** (D) - upgrades available **** or *****

Day 2:

Spend another day in the KNP travelling south, in search of the “Big 5”, and a host of other animals. The KNP is known to be the most diverse park in the world with 140 mammals, 119 reptiles, ± 506 birds, 55 amphibians and ± 1980 plant species. Lunch along the way and dinner will be served as a traditional “braai” - barbeque, prepared by your guide. Overnight in the park.

Accommodation: Satara Camp *** (B & D) - upgrades available **** or *****

Other activities: Enjoy a sunset or evening game drive in an open vehicle with a park ranger.



Day 3:

After an early morning drive through the park, we depart from the park via Orpan Gate. Enjoy a hearty breakfast at the “Mad Dogz” restaurant at Monsoon “Arts & Crafts” centre, before travelling the “Panorama Route” of the majestic Drakensberg Mountains, admire the natural beauty of the Blyde River Canyon - third deepest canyon in the world, Bourke’s Luck Potholes and God’s Window. Lunch at the famous Harries Pancakes in Graskop, and there will also be time to catch up on some shopping. Overnight near Hazyview.

Accommodation: Hippo Hollow Country Lodge *** (B & D) - upgrade available ****



Day 4:

Free to relax or try a new adventure - ballooning, river rafting on the Lower Sabie River (depending on local conditions), “kloofing or canyoning” down river over waterfalls & cliffs, tree-topping or exploring the bush on a 4WD quad bike. This evening, depending on availability we visit Shangaan traditional village to learn about the life, customs and traditions of the Shangaan people, visit the local healer and watch their singing and dancing while sharing a traditional feast in typical huts. Overnight in Hazyview.

Accommodation: Hippo Hollow Country Lodge *** (B & D) - upgrade available ****



Day 5:

A morning at leisure or you could squeeze in another of those adventure activities, before travelling to Johannesburg. Dinner will be served at our charming little lodge near the airport.

Accommodation: Journey’s Inn Africa *** (B & D) - upgrade available **** or *****

Day 6:

The morning at leisure **or** we could visit the Sterkfontein Caves, also known as “The Cradle of Humankind” **or** visit Soweto - reflex on the “Apartheid” era of South Africa’s history. There will be time for last minute shopping before your departure. Transfer to O R Tambo International in time for you to catch your flight home.

Accommodation: - (B)
