Duration: 5 Nights / 6 Days

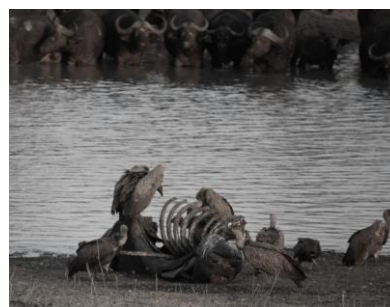
Meals: (B - Breakfast, L - Lunch, D - Dinner)

Day 1:

Depart early morning, after breakfast from your hunting camp or lodge. Travel to the world famous Kruger National Park (KNP). There are a number of interesting places or attractions we could visit on the various routes to the park, the route we take can only be determined on confirmation of accommodation (due to availability). Some of these attractions would be shopping at Gemco Studio, which is known for its “African arts and crafts”, a visit to Bakone Malapa Pedi Cultural Village, Sapeco Tea Estate or the “Big Tree” - which is the largest Baobab in the world at ± 6000 years old. Enter the KNP at one of the northern gates, at an ideal time of the day for some game spotting. Lunch can be enjoyed on route and dinner will be served at the camps restaurant. Overnight in the KNP.

Accommodation: Letaba / Olifants or Satara Camp *** **(D) - upgrades available **** or *******



Day 2:

Spend another day in the KNP travelling south, in search of the “Big 5”, and a host of other animals. The KNP is known to be the most diverse park in the world with 140 mammals, 119 reptiles, ± 506 birds, 55 amphibians and ± 1980 plant species. Lunch along the way and dinner will be served as a traditional “braai” - barbeque, prepared by your guide. Overnight in the park.

Accommodation: Lower Sabie / Skukuza or Pretoriuskop Camp *** **(B & D) - upgrades available **** or *******

Other activities: Enjoy a sunset or evening game drive in an open vehicle with a park ranger.



Day 3:

After breakfast and a leisurely morning we depart from the park via Numbi Gate, transfer to Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport to catch a direct flight at \pm 13h05 to Cape Town (\pm 2 ½ hours). You will have a choice of a couple of touring options on your arrival in South Africa's beautiful Mother City. **First option** - optional and weather permitting, you can take the cableway up Table Mountain. **Second option** - a short orientation city tour, which includes the Castle of Good Hope, City Hall & Parade Ground and DEI Company Gardens. **Third option** - check in at your hotel, afternoon at leisure. Dinner will be served at a restaurant on the V & A Waterfront. Overnight in Cape Town.

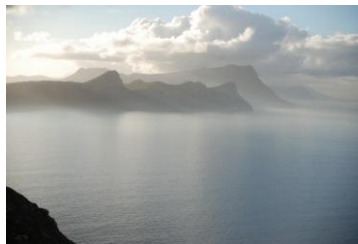

Day 4:

Tour the Cape Peninsula. Take a cruise from Hout Bay to Duiker Island to view a Cape Fur Seal colony. Visit the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve with over 4500 species of Fynbos plants, Cape Point and the Cape of Good Hope - which is the most south-westerly point of the continent of Africa, the Boulders - African penguins and Kirstenbosch National Botanical Gardens. Lunch can be enjoyed at one of the numerous restaurants in Simonstown and then you have an evening at your own leisure. Overnight in Cape Town.

Accommodation: Brenwin Guest House *** **or** Victoria & Alfred Hotel **** **or** Table Bay Hotel **** (B)



Day 5:

Set off after breakfast for a venture into the wine land country near Cape Town. First stop is the delightful town of Stellenbosch, rich in history with the most impressive Cape Dutch architecture. You will have time to wander the oak-lined streets before continuing to Paarl with its imposing Afrikaans Taal Monument. Lunch in the picturesque town of Franschhoek before wine tasting and a cellar tour at one of the local estates. A farewell dinner will be served at the famous Five Flies Restaurant (no children) **or** at one of the restaurants in town with an “African” flavour. Overnight in Cape Town.

Accommodation: Brenwin Guest House *** **or** Victoria & Alfred Hotel **** **or** Table Bay Hotel ***** (B & D)



Day 6:

Morning at leisure. There will be time for last minute shopping at the V & A Waterfront and weather permitting an **optional** helicopter flip over the Cape Peninsula. Transfer to Cape Town International Airport to catch your connecting flight back to Johannesburg or direct flight home.

Accommodation: - (B)

Included: Domestic flights - KMIA to Cape Town / Cape Town to JHB, accommodation, transport, guide, meals as indicated, conservation fees and entrance fees to places of interest.
