

“BIG GAME & BEAUTY”

Tour: Kruger National Park / Panorama – option 1

No of pax: Min 2

Dates: 2007 Hunting Season

Duration: 3 Nights / 4 Days

Meals: (B - Breakfast, L - Lunch, D - Dinner)

* Accommodation is subject to availability, if the under mentioned accommodation is not available we shall endeavor to supply comparable facilities.

Day 1:

Depart early morning, after breakfast from your hunting camp. Travel to the world famous Kruger National Park (KNP). There are a number of interesting places or attractions we could visit on the various routes to the park, the route we take can only be determined on confirmation of accommodation (due to availability). Some of these attractions would be shopping at Gemco Studio, which is known for its “African arts and crafts”, a visit to Bakone Malapa Pedi Cultural Village, an optional “elephant back safari”, a visit to Sapeco Tea Estate or the “Big Tree”- which is the largest Baobab in the world at ± 6000 years old. Enter the KNP at one of the northern gates, at an ideal time of the day for some game spotting. Lunch can be enjoyed on route and dinner will be served at the camps restaurant. Overnight in the KNP.

Accommodation: Mopani / Letaba or Olifants Camp *** (L & D)

Day 2:

Spend another day in the KNP travelling south, in search of the “Big 5”, and a host of other animals. The KNP is known to be the most diverse park in the world with 140 mammals, 119 reptiles, ± 506 birds, 55 amphibians and ± 1980 plant species. Lunch along the way and dinner will be served as a traditional “braai” - barbeque prepared by your guide. Overnight in the park.

Accommodation: Satara Camp *** (B, L & D)

Other activities: Enjoy a sunset or evening game drive in an open vehicle with a park ranger.

Day 3:

Depart from the park via Orpen Gate, breakfast at Monsoon restaurant near Hoedspruit. Travel the “Panorama Route” of the majestic Drakensberg Mountains, visiting places such as the Blyde River Canyon - which is the third deepest canyon in the world, Bourke’s Luck Potholes and God’s Window. There will be time for shopping and lunch at the Famous Harries Pancakes in the picturesque little town of Graskop, before travelling to Muldersdrift on the outskirts of Johannesburg & Pretoria. Dinner will be served at the Carnivore Restaurant, which is one of only two of its kind in the world.

Accommodation: Misty Hills Country Hotel **** (B, L & D)

Day 4:

The morning at leisure **or** we could visit the Sterkfontein Caves, also known as “The Cradle of Humankind” **or** visit Soweto - reflex on the “Apartheid” era of South Africa’s history. There will be time for last minute shopping before your departure. Drop-off at O R Tambo International in time for you to catch your flight home.

Accommodation: - (B & L)

Included: Accommodation, transport, guide, meals as indicated, beverages in moderation, conservation fees and entrance fees to places of interest.
