

“WILDLIFE AND FUN”

Tour: Kruger National Park / Cape Town

No of pax: Min 2

Dates: 2006 Hunting Season

Duration: 5 Nights / 6 Days

Meals: (B - Breakfast, L - Lunch, D - Dinner)

* Accommodation is subject to availability, if the under mentioned accommodation is not available we shall endeavor to supply comparable facilities.

Day 1:

Depart early morning, after breakfast from your hunting camp. Travel to the world famous Kruger National Park (KNP). There are a number of interesting places or attractions we could visit on the various routes to the park, the route we take can only be determined on confirmation of accommodation (due to availability). Some of these attractions would be shopping at Gemco Studio known for its African arts and crafts, a visit to Bakone Malapa Pedi cultural village, an optional “elephant back safari”, a visit to Sapeco Tea Estate or the “Big Tree” - which is the largest Baobab in the world at ± 6000 years old. Enter the KNP via one of the northern gates, spend the rest of the day in the park.

Lunch along the way and dinner at the camps restaurant. Overnight in the KNP.

Accommodation: Letaba / Olifants or Satara Camp *** (L & D)

Day 2:

Spend another day in the KNP traveling south, in search of the “Big 5”, and a host of other animals. The KNP is known to be the most diverse park in the world with 140 mammals, 119 reptiles, ± 506 bird, 55 amphibians and ± 1980 plant species. Lunch along the way and dinner will be a traditional “braai” – barbeque prepared by your guide. Overnight in the park.

Accommodation: Skukuza or Pretoriuskop Camp *** (B, L & D)

Other activities: Enjoy a sunset or evening game drive in an open vehicle with a park ranger.

Day 3:

After breakfast and a leisurely morning we depart from the park via Numbi Gate, transfer to Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport to catch a direct flight at ± 1h25 to Cape Town (± 2 ½ hours). You will have a choice of a couple of touring options on your arrival in South Africa’s beautiful Mother City. **First option** - Weather permitting, we take the cableway up Table Mountain. **Second option** - a short orientation city tour, which includes the Castle of Good Hope, City Hall & Parade Ground and DEI Company Gardens. **Third option** - check in at your hotel, afternoon at leisure. This evening you can enjoy sundowners on Signal Hill before dinner at a restaurant on the V & A Waterfront. Overnight in Cape Town.

Accommodation: PH Sea Point *** or PH President **** or Commodore Hotel ***** (B, L & D)

Day 4:

Tour around the Cape Peninsula. Take a cruise from Hout Bay to Duiker Island to view a Cape Fur Seal colony. Visit - Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve with over 4500 species of Fynbos plants, Cape Point and the Cape of Good Hope - which is the most south-westerly point of the continent of Africa, the Boulders – penguins and Kirstenbosch National Botanical Gardens. Lunch in Simonstown. Evening at your own leisure. Overnight in Cape Town.

Accommodation: PH Sea Point *** or PH President **** or Commodore Hotel ***** (B & L)

Day 5:

Set off after breakfast for a venture into the wine land area near Cape Town. First stop is the delightful town of Stellenbosch, rich in history with the most beautiful Cape Dutch architecture. You will have time to wander the oak-lined streets before continuing to Paarl with its imposing Afrikaans Taal Monument. Lunch in the picturesque town of Franschhoek before wine tasting and a cellar tour at one of the local estates. Dinner at the famous Five Flies Restaurant (no children) or one of the restaurants in town with an “African” flavour. Overnight in Cape Town.

Accommodation: PH Sea Point *** or PH President **** or Commodore Hotel ***** (B, L & D)

Day 6:

Morning at leisure. Time for last minute shopping and lunch at the V & A Waterfront. Transfer to Cape Town Airport for you to catch your connecting flight to Johannesburg.

Accommodation: - (B & L)

Included: Air ticket - KMIA to Cape Town, accommodation, transport, guide, meals as indicated, beverages in moderation, conservation fees and entrance fees to places of interest.
