

# “WILDLIFE, FISHING AND LEISURE”

**Tour:** Kruger National Park / Zululand

**Duration:** 7 Nights / 8 Days

**Meals:** (B - Breakfast, L - Lunch, D - Dinner)

## **Day 1:**

Depart early morning, after breakfast from your hunting camp. Travel to the world famous Kruger National Park (KNP). There are a number of interesting places or attractions we will visit on route to the park, some of these attractions would be shopping at Gemco Studio, which is known for its “African arts and crafts”, a visit to Bakone Malapa Pedi Cultural Village, an optional “elephant back safari”, a visit to Sapeco Tea Estate or the “Big Tree” - which is the largest Baobab in the world at ± 6000 years old. Lunch can be enjoyed on route and dinner will be served at the lodge restaurant. Overnight in Phalaborwa.

**Accommodation:** Sefapane Lodge \*\*\* (L & D)

## **Day 2:**

Enter the KNP at Phalaborwa Gate and spend the day in the KNP travelling south, in search of the “Big 5”, and a host of other animals. The KNP is known to be the most diverse park in the world with 140 mammals, 119 reptiles, ± 506 birds, 55 amphibians and ± 1980 plant species. Lunch along the way and dinner will be served at the lodge restaurant. Overnight in the park.

**Accommodation:** Lukimbi Lodge \*\*\*\*\* (B, L & D)

**Other activities:** Enjoy a sunset or evening game drive in an open vehicle with a park ranger.

## **Day 3:**

After an early morning open vehicle game drive and breakfast we depart from the KNP via one of the southern gates. Today we travel through the kingdom of Swaziland to Zululand. Overnight on a private game reserve situated near the small town of Hluhluwe. Dinner will be served at the camp’s restaurant. Overnight at Bonamanzi.

**Accommodation:** Bonamanzi Lodge \*\*\*\* (B, L & D)

## **Day 4:**

This morning you have an included option of joining the ranger on a game walk, the rest of the morning is at leisure. This afternoon we travel to the Hluhluwe / Umfolozi Game Reserve to enjoy an open vehicle safari, in by-gone years this reserve was the hunting grounds of Zulu Kings. Dinner at the camp’s restaurant. Overnight on Bonamanzi.

**Accommodation:** Bonamanzi Lodge \*\*\*\* (B, L & D)

## **Day 5, 6 & 7:**

Take a cruise on the St Lucia estuary, a lake riddled with crocodiles and hippos in the Greater St Lucia Wetlands, before traveling to Umhlanga, where you will spend the next two days at leisure in Umhlanga with its golden beaches washed by the warm Indian Ocean in a sub - tropical setting. Overnight in Umhlanga.

**Accommodation:** Umhlanga Sands \*\*\*\* (B & D)

**Day 8:**

The morning at leisure, before we transfer you to Durban airport in order for you to catch your connecting flight to Johannesburg.

**Accommodation:** - (B & L)

**Included:** Air ticket – Durban to JHB, accommodation, transport, guide, meals as indicated, beverages in moderation, conservation fees and entrance fees to places of interest.
